This batch has fifteen candidates as one of the candidates was absent as he has gone for Hajj. On the first day Dr. Fatema Jawad Chief Editor, Journal of Pakistan Medical Association was the facilitator who discussed in detail Publication Ethics and scientific misconduct. On second day Mr. Shaukat Ali Jawaid Chief Editor Paksitan Journal of Medical Sciences talked about Role of Editors in improving patient care, How to communicate with public using media besides Emotional blackmail by authors. On June 7th Dr. Masood Jawaid Associate Editor Pak J Med Sci conducted the Hands on training session on how to use Open Journal System while on the last day June 8th Prof. Akhtar Sherin Chief Editor Khyber Univesity Medical Journal talked about Indexation of Journals and the Scientometrics. He also gave examples of serious errors in formatting, page make up and editing of journals by Editors. This was an interactive session in which the participants were encouraged to ask questions to clarify any point they wished needed further elaboration.
