

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The next step will be to find a Mentor who is helpful, identify and collaborate with known researchers in that area, contact senior professors, researches for guidance and invite them to be coauthors if they are interested. Select the right journal, identify journals which encourage and support early career researchers as they take short time in peer review and publishing the manuscripts. Some journals also publish special issues for young researchers. Make sure that the selected journal matches your topic. Publication in Impact Factor Journal is a bit difficult as they have a very stringent peer review system and they also take more time in processing and publications. Do not forget to carefully read




